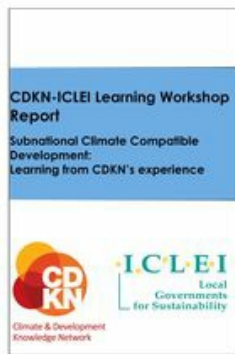
Webinar series topics and speakers announced
