

## Featured news: Major outcomes of ICLEI in Lima

The 20th session of the Conference of the Parties to the UNFCCC in Lima (COP20) was concluded on the 12<sup>th</sup> December 2014. Throughout the Conference, ICLEI advocated for recognition of the role subnational and local authorities play in climate action. In summary, ICLEI's efforts yielded the following:

- Launch of the [Non-state Actor Zone for Climate Action](#) (NAZCA) portal, where ICLEI's carbonn Climate Registry is the primary data provider on local and subnational climate mitigation and adaptation action.
- Launch of the [Global Protocol on Community Scale Greenhouse Gas Emission Inventories](#) (GPC) which marks a major step forward for cities in accurately determining their emission levels.
