Over 40 local governments are getting ready to attend Resilient Cities 2013

Resilient Cities 2013 will kick off in less than a month featuring top city cases on resilience and adaptation from all over the world:

- The **Mayor of Durban, James Nxumalo**, will update the progress in operationalizing the **Durban Adaptation Charter** as an international vehicle for coordinated local government adaptation actions.
- **The Resilient Food Systems Forum** will welcome city representatives from **Linköping (Sweden), Rotterdam (the Netherlands), Toronto (Canada), Belo Horizonte (Brazil), and Kathmandu (Nepal)**.
- **Dar es Salaam, Tanzania** will showcase its practical steps in addressing climate change in the midst of extreme urban growth and high levels of urban poverty.
- **Kaohsiung City** will showcase its work on resilience at the congress exhibition area which will also host a number of companies and organizations, including **UN-Habitat, Esri, German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ), ISOCARP, FSC, Plantagon and Xylem**.
