

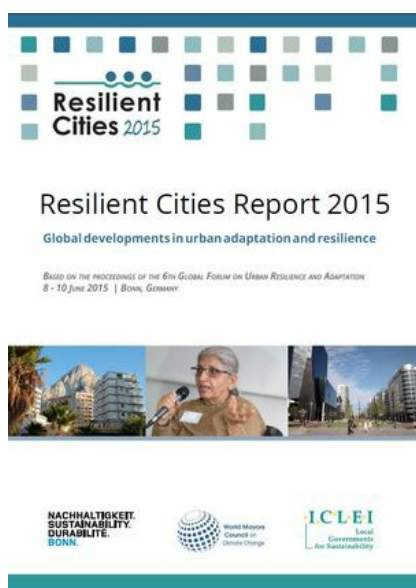

## Call for Contributions for Resilient Cities 2016 opens soon!

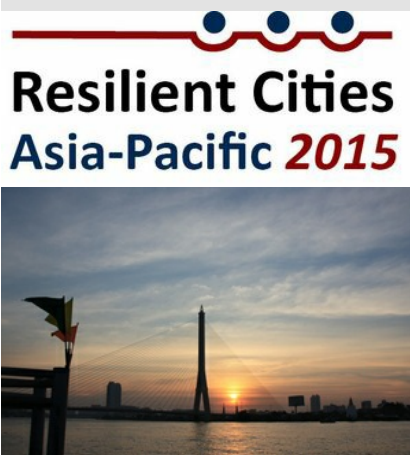
