Submissions are now being accepted for Resilient Cities 2016, the 7th Global Forum on Urban Resilience and Adaptation taking place July 6-8, 2016. Our call for contributions will remain **open until January 8, 2016**.

Core themes/ Forums:

Resilient Cities 2016 will feature a focus on **inclusive and resilient urban development** and provide an international platform for the first annual review of local implementation of **post-2015 global frameworks** (e.g. Sendai Framework, SDGs). It will also continue its strong focus on **financing the resilient city** and zoom in on risk transfer and climate insurance solutions.

Resilient Cities 2016 also calls for examples of:

- Integrated, holistic climate action and resilience planning;
- Urban disaster risk management;
- How cities measure and evaluate resilience (especially with MRV approaches);
- Ecosystem-based adaptation and resilient resource management;
- Advances in knowledge sharing and communicating resilience;
- Managing climate-related health risks (e.g. vector-borne disease, WASH strategies);
- How cities respond to influxes of forced migrants;

and submissions on additional, related topics. Proposals will be accepted for presentations, panels, workshops, posters, Reality Check Workshops, co-events, and alternative formats, including trainings, “talk shows” and “fishbowl” presentations.
